

PRIVACY POLICY

At BIT Incorporated, the protection of your personal information has always been our top priority. Therefore, we are sensitive to safeguarding the privacy of those that visit our Web site. We recognize the need for appropriate protective measures and management of any personal information that you provide to this web site. BIT Incorporated has therefore established this Privacy Policy to assist you in understanding what information we collect and how that information is used.

Your provision of any personal information to BIT Incorporated means you agree that we may collect, use and disclose your information in accordance with our privacy policy. If you do not agree with these terms, please do not provide any personal information to BIT Incorporated.

1) What personally identifiable information does BIT Incorporated collect from you?

In general, you can visit the www.bit-incorp.com web site without telling us who you are or revealing any personal information about yourself. We track visiting Domain's Internet addresses from people who visit us to track a user's session. The user's browser also lets us know the type of computer and operating system are being used. This allows us to identify which parts of our site users spend their time on and the length of their stay, but does not give us any personal information about the user. Specifically, while a user's session will be tracked, the user remains anonymous.

To access certain parts of the Web site, however, we will ask you to voluntarily provide information about yourself. Personal information is collected when you email us with an information request or query. Please see section 3 on security for how this information is protected.

Our website contains links at various points for users to email BIT Incorporated. When you use these links, your email is provided to the administrator of the www.bit-incorp.com website. We only use this information to respond to your inquiry.

We will only collect information to the extent deemed reasonably necessary to serve our legitimate business purposes and to better improve our services. We will maintain appropriate safeguards to ensure the security, integrity and privacy of the information.

We may use the information provided by you to compile demographic and statistical profiles on an aggregate basis in order to analyze our performance.

2) Sharing of personal information

BIT Incorporated has custody and control of the information collected on this site. We will not sell, share, trade, or rent this information to others. When you are at our site and are asked for personal information, you are sharing that information only with BIT Incorporated.

3) Accuracy and Security of information

All reasonable steps are taken to ensure that personal information gathered by BIT Incorporated is as accurate, complete, and up-to-date as is necessary for the purposes for which it is to be used. All reasonable and appropriate security measures are taken to securely store and protect all personal information gathered by BIT Incorporated, such as the requirement of passwords for access and the implementation of firewalls and SSL Encryption with respect to protecting information held in electronic form. Unfortunately, no data protection method or combination of methods can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. Therefore, although we take all reasonable steps to attempt to insure that your personal information is secure, we cannot insure or warrant our ability to do so. Despite our attempts to insure that your personal information remains secure, there is always the possibility that some unauthorized person may find a way to access personal information around our security system. There is also, of course, a negligible risk that information transmitted over the Internet will be intercepted. Therefore, your use of this Web site must be at your own risk, as we will not be liable for disclosures of your personal information due to unauthorized acts of third parties, or transmissions, which are intercepted.

4) Cookies
